Things to do:

 - Diving, snorkelling and angling

- Or simply enjoy a glass of wine and watch our spectacular sunsets over to the Cape of Good Hope.



Directions: From Cape Town (160km) take the N2 over Sir Lowry's Pass. Branch off on to the R43, travel through Hermanus and then further past Stanford towards Gansbaai. 3km before Gansbaai take the first De Kelders turnoff to the right (Guthrie Street). At the sea, turn right into Cliff Street, travelling along the coast to No. 29.
